Minutes Board of Directors Meeting

Mark called the meeting to order at 7:35 P.M.

Motion: Brian made a motion to accept the minutes as written. Joe seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Joe Lanute reported that the current register balance ending 8/8/96 is \$9,980.44. This includes dues deposits of \$920.00 and payments of \$9.10 to the Newsletter and \$52.35 to Landscaping.

Motion: Mamee made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report. Andy seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Entertainment: The annual "Taste of River Oaks" picnic will be held on Saturday, September 14th with a rain date of Sunday, September 15th. Brian will get a flyer out to all homeowners and the committee will contact the residents to confirm their attendance and note the dish each family is bringing.

City Liaison: Mark reported that the City will complete all public property items from the Anden settlement this Fall. These items include straightening street light poles at lots 8 and 15, and extending the sewer line between lots 39 and 40 from the street to riprap in an effort to prevent future flooding in this area. Additionally, the City will fix drainage

problems in the lower bowl of the upper Common Area which were begun last year. All of these items are subject to City Council approval before any work commences.

Landscaping: Thank you, Ellie Kleine for weeding the subdivision entrance! The Landscaping Committee urges all homeowners to take care of the parkway trees on their property. The trees had a difficult winter, and now are suffering from a dry summer. Please water them so that they will go into winter in a healthy condition!

New Business: Mark suggested that a tree from the River Oaks Tree Nursery be donated to the City in memory of River Oaks resident Millie Murphy. The tree will have a plaque on it and the Natural Areas Commission will be consulted to ascertain the best location for the tree.
